Collaborative Effort of Central West OHT, WellFort CHS and Rexdale CHC Improves Health Equity and Access

The teams behind the collaborative Cervical Screening Model have been honoured with the prestigious Quality and Innovation Award from the Cancer Quality Council of Ontario (CQCO). This recognition celebrates our commitment to advancing health equity and improving cervical cancer screening rates in under-served communities.

The initiative, developed and implemented an integrated delivery model with Rexdale CHC has achieved remarkable success in addressing barriers to screening, including structural access, cultural and religious considerations, and socioeconomic challenges.

Key Achievements:

- A 12% increase in screening rates in target communities.
- A 24% improvement in the most under-screened neighborhood in the province.
- A 3% overall population health improvement across the Central West OHT.
